

# Green Mountain College Tuition Rates and Employee Enrollment Policies

## 2008-2009

### Full-time tuition:

\$24,938.00 for the 2008-2009 academic year; given an average course load for ten courses per academic year this rate is equivalent to \$2,494.00 per three credit course or \$832.00 per credit hour.

### Part-time tuition for 6 credits per semester or less:

\$1,485.00 per three-credit course or \$495.00 per credit hour; this rate is applicable only for part-time **non-matriculated** (max. of 15 credits over life) students who enroll for 6 credit hours or less per term. No institutional financial aid is applicable. Students are subject to applicable class fees. All costs are payable at time of registration.

### Community Tuition Rate:

\$741.00 per three-credit course or \$247.00 per credit hour; this rate is applicable only for part-time, **non-matriculating** students who enroll for 6 credit hours or less per term, and who are permanent residents of the town of Poultney (proof of residency required). Admission at the community rate can only be granted after full-time students have been accommodated. No institutional financial aid is applicable. Students are subject to applicable class fees. All costs are payable at time of registration.

### Non-credit Tuition-Rate: Audit

\$741.00 per three-credit course or \$247.00 per credit hour; this rate is applicable only for part-time, **non-matriculating** students who enroll for 6 credit hours or less per term, and who wish to take courses on a not-for-credit (audit) basis. Students who audit a course will not receive a course grade and will be accommodated only with permission of the instructor. Students are subject to applicable class fees. No institutional financial aid is applicable.

### Senior Scholars:

Available to persons 60 years of age and older – preference to Poultney residents. One course per semester may be audited without charge; courses taken for credit will be available at \$475.00 per course. A total of two courses or 6 credit hours (including an audited class) may be taken by non-matriculating seniors. Students are subject to applicable class fees. No institutional financial aid is applicable.

### Poultney High School Scholars Program:

Available to gifted and talented Poultney High School students, subject to recommendation of the High School. The program is limited to two courses or 6 credit hours per semester. Tuition is \$150 for the first course plus applicable class fees (which are paid by the High School) and \$225 for the second course (payable by student at time of registration along with any applicable class fee).

### Young Scholars Program:

Available to gifted and talented high school age students (non-matriculating), subject to standard admission process. The program is limited to two courses per semester. Tuition is \$225 per course plus applicable class fees.

### Tuition-free Status: (All tuition cancellation requires employees to be full time for 90 days.)

Full-time employees of Green Mountain College are eligible to enroll in one undergraduate course per semester free of charge. The second course per semester may be requested but is contingent upon arrangements for compensatory time being made with the employee's direct supervisor and requires the approval of the responsible cabinet officer. Green Mountain College employees can only be granted course admission after full-time, tuition paying students have been accommodated.

Spouses and civil union partners of full-time employees of Green Mountain College are eligible to take two undergraduate courses per semester free of charge. Course admission can only be granted after full-time tuition paying students have been accommodated.

Dependent children (up to two dependents per academic year) of full-time employees of Green Mountain College are eligible to enroll as full-time undergraduate students free of tuition charges. Admission is subject to the college's admissions policies and cannot be guaranteed. Financial aid application is also required. All fees apply as listed in the college catalogue and/or the college web site. Dependents who wish to be admitted as full-time residential students are subject to room and board charges as listed in the college catalogue.

Dependent children may be eligible and receive tuition discounts/benefits at other institutions as part of the tuition exchange program.

These tuition exemptions are not applicable to summer courses or special programs. Summer course and special program tuition rates apply as listed in the respective course materials and announcements

**Graduate Program:** Full time GMC employees may receive a significant discount once accepted into the graduate program.

Formal admissions policy applies and participation granted after full tuition paying students have been accommodated.
